  - b. Focus on the main events – NOT JUST ONE EVENT!!
  - c. Do NOT give away the ending.
- 9. Slide 9: Theme
  - a. What lesson do you think the author is trying to teach you through the characters experiences?
  - b. This should be a lesson we can apply to our lives, not just in the book.
- 10. Slide 10: Character Development
  - a. How did Katniss's character develop over the course of the text?
  - b. How did Peeta's character develop over the course of the text?
- 11. Slide 11: Compare and Contrast life in Panem with Life in the united states.

  - a. What did you like about this book? Why?
  - b. Who would you recommend this book to? Why?
